

Who Should Attend?

Ideally participants for the doula training should have one or more of the following before the workshop:

1. Attend a childbirth education class as an observer; observe for class content, group dynamics and adult learning principles.
2. Have training or certification as a childbirth educator.
3. Be a nursing student or registered nurse.
4. Be a midwifery student or midwife.

All participants should be familiar with anatomy of the reproductive system and breasts; physiology of pregnancy, birth, postpartum and breastfeeding; definitions of medical terms regarding labor; common procedures and tests used during normal birth, their risks and benefits; pain medications and their administration/side effects; cesarean birth; VBAC; normal newborn appearances and procedures; basic relaxation techniques breathing patterns and breastfeeding. A pre-workshop study guide will be provided upon registration and must be completed prior to the training and brought to the training.

Becoming A Doula

Birth Doulas nurture the mother and the expectant family. Over twenty-five years of research studies and over 3000 years of artifacts substantiate a woman's need for knowledgeable companionship during labor and birth; that when trained labor support persons or doulas attend births, labors may be shorter, there is less need for medication to speed labor, less need for a forcep delivery, pain medication, epidural medication or cesarean section. It has also been shown that babies may breastfeed more easily. Doulas do not take the place of nurses or physicians ~ they do no clinical tasks. Over 20 years of research by physicians such as Drs. Marshall Klaus and John Kennell show that it is the continuous social support that reduces statistics.



About The Training
